- Renovates Phelps Hall, constructed in the 1960s.
- Second phase of a multi-phase overall campus space plan to address critical space needs for the sciences, humanities, and social sciences.
- Corrects code deficiencies and upgrades major building-utility systems.
- Includes renovation of released space, converting it to: one, modern specialized teaching and research laboratories for use as computer and teaching laboratories for students; and two, offices, teaching space, and research space for departments in the sciences, engineering, and humanities.
