- Modernizes vacant wet laboratory space required to permanently relocate lab programs from the Clinical Sciences Building, which must be vacated for seismic retrofit and renovation.
- Accommodates School of Medicine research laboratories with a full-floor renovation that replaces walls, floors, ceilings, lighting, HVAC, sprinklers, benches, fume hoods, built-in furniture, etc.
- Supports Parnassus Heights Long Range Renewal Plan to upgrade obsolete wet laboratory space at the Parnassus campus site and remediate seismic risks.
