

**Davis Hospital Seismic Upgrade Fire, Life, Safety (UCDMC)**

**Fiscal Year:** 2014-15

**Project Description**

- Provides fire, life, and safety upgrades to the Main Hospital that are required prior to the demolition of the North / South Wing.
- Includes adding a fully automatic fire protection system and replacing the old fire alarm system with a new Notifier Fire Alarm System, in all areas of the East Wing. A new fire alarm system must be added to the East Wing because the old control panels are located in the North/South Wing, where the demolition will occur, and the panels cannot be relocated due to the age of the system.
- Associated with the larger effort of Hospital Seismic Upgrades that are all tied to the hospital’s overall seismic compliance plan.
- Part of the UCDSHS Sacramento Campus Hospital Seismic Master Plan to meet CA SB 1953 mandates.
