Riverside Barn Expansion

Project Description

- The vision is to dramatically enhance the existing dining and entertainment venue while recognizing the Barn Group (1916) cultural importance to the campus.
- Renovates and expands the Barn (i.e., new kitchen, serving area, and seating), creates a coffee house (Cottage), provides a meeting and private event space (Barn Stable), and establishes the Faculty/Staff Dining Facility.
- The project expands the dining capabilities to accommodate the campus population as identified in the 2011 Dining Services Master Planning Study, and provides a larger entertainment venue. Once completed, the total indoor and outdoor capacity will increase from 370 to 550 seats.
- Outdoor dining seating will be located in two courtyards. The West Courtyard is also an entertainment venue that incorporates a stage, appropriate sound and lighting, shade structure, and other environmental enhancements for outdoor productions (e.g., bands, comedy, lecture, dance, etc).
- The Barn is one of the most popular Campus dining venues and is a social gathering place for UCR's campus community.
