- Addresses seismic deficiencies of the 52 year-old Freeborn Hall which has a "very poor" rating through renewal and potential expansion of existing facility.
- Provides for facility needs for a multi-use auditorium space for festival style events and can accommodate seated dining to meet current programmatic needs.
- Captures required renovations related to life safety, accessibility, and the partial replacement of the failing building systems (accessibility upgrades, finish repair, HVAC work, fire sprinkler installation, fire alarm replacement, electrical and lighting improvements, replacement of exterior canopy, etc.).
