## **Project Description**

San Francisco

- Constructs a new academic research building, including wet lab (40%) and dry/office space (60%), to house some UCSF faculty, staff, and students who currently occupy seismically deficient academic buildings on the City's SFGH campus, B/C Lot.
- Additional seismic retrofit projects will mitigate seismically unsafe academic buildings that house the remainder of faculty, staff, and students that do not relocate to this new building.
- The campus is negotiating with the City of San Francisco to secure ground lease rights for the City land identified for this new building.
