Why We Need a Staffing Plan

- **Budget pressure:** need to prioritize use of resources
- **Space constraints:** must estimate space need, consolidate as possible
- **UCPath:** compressed schedule means increased staffing, fast ramp up
- **IT skillsets:** needs are changing
- **Opportunities:** staff should be informed

Planning Principles

- **Constant reassessment:** Review of vacant positions to address changing needs and opportunities
 - Backfills not automatic
- **Organizational flexibility**
 - UCPath implementation positions: primarily contract employees & contractors
- **Career mobility:** within ITS, across UC
 - Notices of postings sent to ITS-I listserv
 - Check postings on UCOP jobs site

Plan Overview

- **Scope:** all ITS, including UCPath *implementation & support*
- **Timeframe:** March 2014 –October 2015
- **Process:**
 - ITS and UCPath functional needs defined with managers (thanks to Wendy Rager)
 - PMO independently reviewed UCPath needs
 - ITS and PMO agreed on final plan

Accelerated Recruitment Process for UCPath

- **Number:** About 65 positions - aggressive recruitment schedule
- **When:** Hiring now – focused support from HR team
 - Positions open 2-3 weeks
- **Peak:** Staff numbers peak in July 2014 and June 2015
