

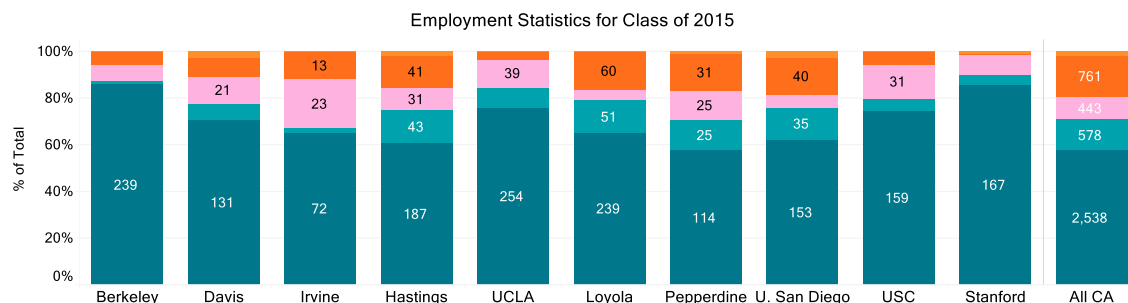
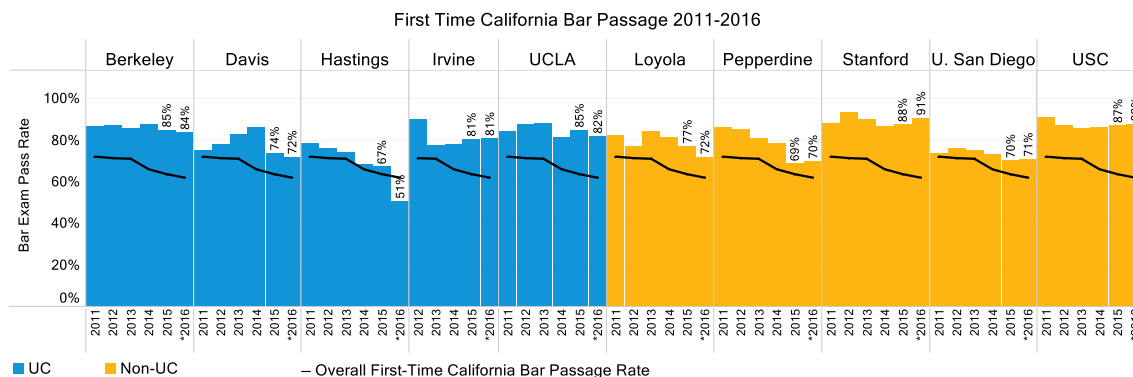
UC Law Student Outcomes Are Comparable to Other California Law Schools

The University of California produces approximately 27 percent of all graduates from California law schools accredited by the American Bar Association. From 2011-2015, UC graduates outperformed statewide first time Bar Exam passage rates and had comparable employment outcomes relative to other top California law schools. In the June 2016 administration of the Bar Exam, most UC law schools maintained relatively high Bar Exam passage rates despite continued declines in the state average.
