III. FINANCIAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Certain UC officials must file a statement pertaining to their financial interests in entities outside UC. Recruitment listings for designated officials must include notice of the financial disclosure statement. The following language is recommended: "Under the provisions of the Political Reform Act of 1974, the successful candidate will be required to file a Statement of Economic Interests."
