Dear Colleagues:

At their November 1998 meeting, The Regents delegated authority to the President to set fees for self-supporting degree programs. Consistent with that delegation, in May, I approved fees for self-supporting programs for the 2012-13 year. With this letter, I am correcting the fee level for one additional program, the Master of Advanced Study – Maternal and Child Nutrition at the Davis campus, and modifying the billing basis of the Master of Professional Accountancy and Online Master of Science and Engineering programs at the Riverside campus.

These fees are effective fall 2012 unless otherwise noted. The approved fees are based on documentation submitted by the campuses. A revised report summarizing the approved fee levels for self-supporting programs at all campuses will be provided to The Regents, consistent with their November 1998 action.

As provided in University policy, annual revenue from each program must be sufficient to cover all direct and indirect costs for the program to be self-supporting. As part of the process to approve fee increases, your campus will be asked to provide expenditure data for each program on an annual basis.
