The 2010-11 Budget Act requires that the University of California provide a report to the Legislature on funding levels for Student Academic Preparation and Educational Partnerships (SAPEP) in 2010-11. Specifically, the language reads:

"16. The University of California shall provide a plan to the Department of Finance and the fiscal committees of each house of the Legislature for expenditure of state and university funds for student academic preparation and education programs (SAPEP) by September 1 of each year. The university shall not reduce funding for these programs, relative to 2009-10 levels. The university shall submit a report on funding levels of SAPEP to the fiscal committees of each house of the Legislature no later than April 1, 2011."

University of California Response

Attached is a table showing funding levels for Student Academic Preparation and Educational Partnership Programs in 2010-11. The University is spending \$29.6 million on SAPEP Programs in 2010-11. There is no change in the program budgets between 2009-10 and 2010-11.
