Report on Project Savings Program Funded from Capital Outlay Bond Funds

Project Savings Program

Consistent with Item 6440-401 of the Budget Act of 2010, this report is on the use of identified savings in construction funds appropriated from the 2006 Higher Education Capital Outlay Bond Fund. For the item identified above, the Budget Act provides that by December 1 annually the University of California shall provide the Legislative Analyst with a report showing the identified savings by project and the purpose for which the identified savings were used for the prior year.

During the 2009-10 fiscal year, the University of California used these provisions to authorize the use of project savings from the following project.

Irvine campus.

There were \$3,016,919 in project savings from the Steinhaus Hall Seismic Improvements project (Chapter 171/2007, Item 6440-302-6028[4]).

- Of this amount, \$2,668,000 was reverted and these funds were subsequently added as an appropriation to the 2010 Budget Act for the Arts Building Equipment project.
- Of the amount of \$348,919 in project savings after the reversion discussed above, \$147,000 was used for the Animal Facility Security Upgrade project, \$112,000 was used for the Med Sci A Air Handler Unit Upgrade project, \$55,919 was used for the Central Plant Chillers Hoist System Upgrade project, and \$34,000 was used for Electrical Upgrades at McGaugh Hall, Social Sciences Laboratory, Kreiger Hall, and Humanities Hall.

There were no identified savings in construction funds appropriated from other Higher Education Capital Outlay Bond Funds during 2009-10.
