NOTES: Medical and law school students pay a Special Fee of \$376 per year in addition to graduate fees
Beginning in 1994-95, students in the professional fields of medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine, business, and law pay a Professional School fee in addition to graduate fees
The amount of the Professional Fee is determined by the student's year of entry: 1994-95: \$2000/ 1995-96: \$3000 for medicine, dentistry, and vet med; \$4000 for business and law
1996-97: \$4000 for medicine, dentistry, and vet med; \$6000 for business and law/ 1997-98 and 1998-99: \$4000 for vet med \$5000 for medicine and dentistry; \$6000 for business and law
Riverside: Graduate business students (MBA) who enrolled in 1995-96 pay a Professional Fee of \$3000 per year, those enrolling in 1996-97, \$4000 per year; 1997-98 and 1998-99: \$5000 per year
Beginning in 1996-97, students in the professional fields of optometry, pharmacy, and nursing will pay a Professional School fee in addition to graduate fees
The amount of the Professional Fee is determined by a student's year of entry: 1996-97: \$2000 for optometry and pharmacy; \$1500 for nursing
1997-98 and 1998-99: \$3000 for optometry and pharmacy; \$1800 for nursing. Theater, Film, and Television MFA students (UCLA only) pay \$2000 if admitted 1996-97 or later
San Francisco: Undergraduate fees apply to dental hygiene students. Graduate fees apply to graduate academic students
San Diego: Entering freshmen pay an additional \$105 in mandatory orientation fees; entering transfers pay an additional \$40 in mandatory orientation fees
Campus Fees listed by category -- actual fee name may differ and/or amount may represent more than one fee. All fees subject to change without notice.
All professional degree students (residents and nonresidents) pay the nonresident fee differential
