Appendix H: Selected Students Comments

Importance of Personal Attention

“UC Berkeley is an excellent institution which has great academics and a very favorable reputation. My main reason for selecting Stanford University over UC Berkeley was primarily because of smaller class sizes and more attention towards individual students. UC Berkeley is very large with a huge student body and not as able to connect with each student individually.”

“I chose Dartmouth because of the remarkable, personal interest students and administrators took in welcoming students to their school. It seemed like they really wanted the students to come; at the overnight session, students expressed amazing pride and confidence in their school. It seemed like that was lacking at Berkeley; a lot of students felt the administration didn't pay attention to undergrads and some were unhappy. There was none of that at Dartmouth. But I really liked Berkeley's campus.”

“The Claremont 5-college system ... offers the resources of a large University with the personal attention of a small college.”

“I feel that Notre Dame offers more personalized attention, smaller classes, and a better chance to know my professors. At UCLA, I would be just a number.”

“I chose Cornell because of the Ivy League status that even the best UCs can not approach. They took the time to call me and gave me a great deal of personal attention. They even paid for my flight to see the campus. Davis called me only once, after I had made my decision, and I felt they weren't even in the ballpark when it came to the personal attention I received from Cornell. They made me feel like I was more than a number, something of which the UC system has made a bad habit.”

“UC Santa Cruz, even though it is the smallest UC school, is just too big and I don't think I would get the personal attention and support (emotional and academic)[that I would get] at a smaller liberal arts school like Occidental College.”

Importance of Financial Aid

“I was very disappointed that I was not offered a scholarship to UCLA for my academic accomplishments. If UCLA had offered me a scholarship, I would have seriously considered attending. Stanford University obviously wanted me there more than UCLA did. I am happy with my decision.”

“They offered me a Presidential Scholarship, A full ride because I have a 4.3 and am valedictorian.” {Student choosing CSU Long Beach instead of UC Irvine}

“UC San Diego did not send me a financial aid package by May 1st. I could not chose to attend UC San Diego since I did not even know if my financial options were better than Mount St. Mary's. I do not understand why I never received an estimate, especially since I'm an eligible candidate for financial aid. UC San Diego is in an excellent location and has a great reputation. I would have given it a lot more consideration if I had known of my financial options and if the school was more centered on personal attention.”

“Money talks. I would have had to pay out-of-state tuition at UNC. Although they offered me more scholarships/grants, I would still have had to pay more there. But not much more. As far as academic offerings, UCSB and UNC were roughly equal, so in the end it came down to total cost (after financial aid) and overall personal preference.”

“Obviously I wanted to go to Reed but didn't receive enough financial aid. I wasn't really considering UCSC, but when it came down to it, it was the next best thing. I chose it over Berkeley because I think I'd have more fun at Santa Cruz. I do want to attend UC Santa Cruz, but the fact that I am receiving a Regents Scholarship certainly helps.”

Importance of Housing

“I was accepted early decision to Stanford, and had made up my mind before then because they offer 4 years of housing for undergraduates and because of the atmosphere.”

“UC San Diego was too big for me, and there isn't housing after one year.”

“I found the housing cost to be the main reason why I did not choose UCSC. Housing is available and relatively inexpensive in Oregon while it is the complete opposite in Santa Cruz.”

“Berkeley is too big for me; I like the idea of a more personal education. Also, the shortage of housing is a really big discouraging factor at Berkeley.”

“After attending Pitzer's "On Campus Day", I knew that it was a perfect fit for me. Also, I am graduating two years early, and my parents insisted on me attending a school where I was guaranteed four year housing.”

Importance of Other Reasons

Sports Programs

“Riverside has a track and cross country program; LMU does not.”

“UCLA has one of the best athletic programs in the country, or from a student's perspective anyways. The ability to attend sporting events like basketball and football with a high-caliber team, in a highly qualified academic institution, creates the best "winning" combination a college campus could ever afford. In my personal opinion, UCLA is the best university in the nation, with the perfect balance of sports, academics, and social opportunities.”

Academic Options/ Specialized Programs

“I applied under Early Decision and was accepted. Early Decision is a binding commitment to attend if accepted.” {Student choosing Yale University over UC Irvine}

“I decided to go to GT (Georgetown Univ.) because they have a wonderful co-op program in which I will take 5 years to graduate but I will be working for a private corporation during at least 4 semesters during 5 years.”

“CMC [Claremont McKenna College] "wait listed" me and then bumped me up to official acceptance, thus financial aid was lagging, to say the least. I was also concerned about my

happiness in a politically conservative environment, as a "bleeding-heart" liberal. UCLA offered me the College Honors Program and a scholarship, so I felt more wooed. In addition, my older sister goes to UCLA which was just added incentive."

Size of Classes

"I like Stanford because it has a smaller student body which means more access to professors and other opportunities like research and internships. It also guarantees housing all four years and has a beautiful campus. The people at Stanford are all very friendly and open and everyone you ask says they love the school, and encourages you to come to their school. In terms of Engineering, which is what I intend to major in, Berkeley and Stanford are pretty much equal. But it is harder to get the classes you need at Berkeley. That's why a Regents at Berkeley, which would have meant priority registration, might have changed my mind."

Religious Affiliation

"I knew that at Westmont I would get a lot of Christian exposure, where as at UCI there was barely any religion there at all."

Family and/or Friends in Attendance

"My brother attended UCR, and he has a major impact on me. I would like to be just like him."

"My cousin and friends are UC Los Angeles alumni"

Future Employment Opportunities

"Knowledge that the Alumni Association works so well that when I graduate and enter into the job field, I can attain a position at a higher level, with better pay, due to the contacts with Alumni. No other school is able to offer that kind of practical service to such an amazing extent."

Appendix I: Technical Appendix

Methodology

Based on the success of the web-based Graduate Support Survey pilot conducted in 2000, a web-based methodology was chosen for the Undergraduate Student Support Survey. Because the population of admitted undergraduate students with e-mail and those without e-mail differed along several important characteristics, including average parent income levels and ethnicity, the web survey was augmented with a smaller telephone survey in order to ensure a representative sample. The design of the web site and the administration of the web and telephone survey were completed by a contractor, Field Research Corporation.

Sample Sizes

Gift aid, which includes grants, scholarships, and any other money that doesn't have to be paid back, was the variable of greatest interest; therefore, sample sizes were calculated based on a formula that used the standard deviation in the mean gift aid of the population to be sampled. Because the standard deviation was not known, the standard deviation of the mean gift aid for UC financial aid recipients from the academic year 1999-2000 was used instead. The goal was that the mean gift aid estimates from the final system-wide sample of undergraduate students admitted to UC would have a 95% confidence level of being within plus or minus 5% of the true mean of the gift aid parameter of the population.

The target response rate was 50%. As an incentive, cash prizes were offered (one \$1,000 and two \$500) in an effort to ensure the desired response rate. Winners were randomly drawn from a list of those who completed the questionnaire.

Survey Administration

On April 30, 2001, the sample of students with e-mail addresses (17,581) was mailed a letter that included a brief description of the survey, mention of the cash prizes, as well as the URL address that they could use to enter the web site and complete the questionnaire. On May 4, 2001, these students were sent an email inviting them to fill out the questionnaire. A direct link to the survey web site was included in the email. The first e-mail reminder was sent on May 10, 2001, and the two more e-mail reminders were sent on May 17th & 24th. The decision on the timing of the emails was based on the positive results of the timing and response to reminders in the Graduate Student Support Survey pilot. The survey was left up on the web until June 22, 2001.

Calculating Net Cost

The mean net cost of attendance was calculated for each school chosen. Students were asked to report the cost of attendance listed on their financial aid letter; however, many students did not provide any information or provided information that was obviously wrong. In order to establish a more accurate cost of attendance for each school, the cost that the student listed on the survey was compared to the cost of attendance reported by the school to the College Board for Fall 2001. Information supplied by the student about where they planned to live was used to determine whether the on-campus, living at home, or commuting but not living at home budget was used. In-state costs were used to compare all California colleges while out-of-state costs were used for non-California

schools. When the student listed a cost of attendance that was within 10% of the cost listed by the College Board, the student's answer was used in the calculation. Otherwise, the information from the College Board was used in all calculations about cost.

The amount reported for the various different types of grants and loans was also examined carefully. Observations where the information reported seemed unreasonable were thrown out before any analysis of the financial aid data was done. The table below shows the parameters used to determine reasonableness. The net cost to the student was calculated by subtracting all the various types of gift aid that the student listed (including Pell grants, Cal grants, other grants, scholarships, employer support, and any other money that does not have to be repaid) from the cost of attendance.
