Dear Colleagues:

On January 20, 2016, the NIH announced its new fiscal year 2016 NRSA (National Research Service Award) stipend levels for Postdoctoral Scholars. The new annual minimum is \$43,692 for newly hired postdoctoral scholars. A copy of the NIH announcement is found online at http://grants.nih.gov/grants/guide/notice-files/NOT-OD-16-047.html.

Pursuant to the Postdoctoral Scholars' MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) between the University of California and the UAW union, Article 4, Compensation, the enclosed University's salary scale for Postdoctoral Scholar salary/stipend minimum rates has been increased in accordance with the NIH announcement pertaining to NRSA stipend levels. The effective date of the new rates is February 1, 2016, which is the first day of the payroll period following the NIH announcement. The new rates will apply when a Postdoctoral Scholar is newly appointed, reappointed, or on the anniversary date for those Postdoctoral Scholars with multiple year appointments. For Kirschstein Fellowships, the new minimum applies to all awards made on or after October 1, 2015. Retroactive adjustments or supplementation of stipends or other budgetary categories with Kirschstein-NRSA funds for an award made prior to October 1, 2015 are not permitted.
