Re: Issuance of Revisions to Academic Personnel Manual (APM) Section 715, Leaves of Absence/Family and Medical Leave (APM - 715), and Section 760, Family Accommodations for Childbearing and Childrearing (APM - 760)

# Dear Colleagues:

I am formally issuing revised Academic Personnel Manual (APM) section 715, Leaves of Absence/Family and Medical Leave (APM - 715) and APM section 760, Accommodations for Childbearing and Childrearing, (APM - 760), effective immediately. The revised APM - 715 and APM - 760 may be found online on the <u>Academic Personnel and Programs website</u>.

On September 29, 2022, Governor Newsom signed AB1041 which permits employees to take leave under CFRA to care for a "designated person" with a serious health condition. This legislation went into effect January 1, 2023. The technical revisions to APM - 715 and APM - 760 are necessary to bring the policies into compliance with the CFRA amendment and to clarify that PFCB is not a pay option available during leave to care for a designated person. Revisions were made to the following policy sections:

### • 715-0 Policy

Added designated person and defined designated person.

• 715-16, Duration and Timing of Family and Medical Leave

Added designated person.

# • 715-20, Pay Status

- Clarified that PFCB is not a pay option available during leave to care for a designated person.
- Added designated person under Other Pay Options During a Family and Medical Leave to section b.

### • 715-30, Notice and Certification

Added designated person.

# • 760-27, Childbearing Leave

Clarified that PFCB is not a pay option available during leave to care for a designated person.
