- Construction of new building (65,500 gsf) adjacent to existing 3-building Haas School complex (1995) and renovation of existing Student Building (97,100 gsf).
- Project objectives include: accommodate 70% enrollment growth in the School since 1995; provide instructional spaces that reflect changes in instructional models, work styles, and technology; provide state of the art research facilities with the potential for future growth and revenue generation; and repurpose currently underutilized spaces such as the library to meet current and future mission needs.
- Campus will proceed to budget approval only when financial strategy is determined to be viable, based on fundraising progress.
- Project to be constructed as donor development.
