

Jules Stein Seismic Renovation

- Corrections to improve the seismic-force-resisting system of the Jules Stein Eye Institute (a reinforced concrete building constructed in 1967) from a rating of Level V to Level III (formerly UC “Poor” to “Good”). “Poor” to “Good.”
- Also includes fire and life-safety upgrades, accessibility improvements, and asbestos removal, and renovations to two laboratory floors
- The project will commence following completion of the Wasserman Building project in 2012-13.
- Part of the campus’s Seismic Safety Program.
