KITP Residence

- Constructs a 41-unit apartment complex for visiting physicists and their families during visits to Kavli Institute for Theoretical Physics. Creates important community space to encourage and enhance scientific interactions.
- The KITP hosts 1,000 visiting scholars per year with an average visit duration of 36 days. These visitors are currently accommodated in the Santa Barbara community through a network of residential contacts; the Residence will stabilize KITP's ability to secure housing for longer-term visitors and will increase scholarly interactions.
- Redirects per diem grant funding from community rentals into equity within a University-owned facility.
