

Tolman Hall Seismic Replacement

- Existing Tolman Hall (1962) has 'poor' seismic rating, inadequate and obsolete building systems, and poor spatial configuration.
- Replaces existing building with a new building on alternate site to house the Department of Psychology and School of Education.
- Highest campus priority for seismic correction, based on life-safety risk.
- Project listed as state-eligible per UCOP request for projects for potential Nov 2014 GO bond measure, but campus also actively pursuing alternate funding strategies.
- Project budget includes \$10,000,000 for demolition of existing building after completion of replacement.
