Project Description

- The Biomedical Library in the Center for Health Sciences (CHS) is a nine-story building constructed between 1951-1965.
- The separate CHS Seismic Correction and Fire Safety project, currently underway, is upgrading the seismic rating of Level V to Level III (formerly, UC "Poor" to "Good"); additional infrastructure improvements are needed upgrade the building for the next generation of use.
- The project provides fire/life safety improvements, building systems upgrades, window replacement, accessibility improvements, and hazardous materials abatement.
- The building currently accommodates a campus library and SOM academic programs.
