## Riverside A-I Residential Restaurant Replacement

Fiscal Year: 2015-16

## **Project Description**

- Construct a new residential restaurant at Aberdeen-Inverness (A-I) Residence Hall to meet the current and future residential student populations. The proposed location and building delivery method (e.g., P3, design build, etc) will be examined as part of the planning/design phase.
- The new facility will incorporate a catering kitchen, grab and go production, and the food truck program.
- The present A-I residential restaurant is at capacity, and overflow is being supported by the food truck parked behind the restaurant. The need for the new restaurant was identified in the 2011 Dining Services Master Planning Study.
