Project Description

- Addresses need for UCSC's faculty and students, visiting scholars and the public to have a place to create, collaborate and share innovative or experimental displays.
- Creates an intellectual hub at the intersections of the arts, humanities, sciences and social sciences by providing space and opportunity for hands-on participation, curatorial innovation, multi-disciplinary curricular activities, community outreach, and previously-unexplored synergies. Also provides capacity to showcase traveling exhibitions.
- Constructs a 19,000 asf visual research and exhibition building with flexible exhibition, screening, gallery, collaboration, research, teaching and study spaces, staff and faculty offices, conference room, reception/registration areas, and storage.
- The selected project site is at the confluence of the Great Meadow, the Oak ecotone and the redwood forest at the eastern edge of the Arts Area in the geographic center of campus.
- Supports campus CFP objectives for Instruction and Research Program Development.
- P phase funding being considered in 2015-16. This gift-funded project will move forward when sufficient funding is available (forecasted 2016-17).
