- Builds out 7,100 square feet of shell space in the Gavin Herbert Eye Institute (GHEI) to provide additional operating rooms, prep/recovery beds, and support space.
- Doubles the procedure capacity of the GHEI with the construction of 2 new operating rooms.
- Alleviates scheduling congestion at the Outpatient Surgery Center located in the Chao Family Comprehensive Cancer Center at the Medical Center.
- Provides modern and efficient clinical space for both patients and staff.
- Supports the performance goals of the Medical Center to achieve excellence in quality patient care, patient service and patient experience.
