DESCRIPTION

The Irvine campus is requesting approval of \$50,321 for maintenance work on the Tierney University House (The House).

At the March 2006 meeting, the President notified the Committee on Grounds and Buildings of the changes to Delegations of Authority for approval of capital projects for the Chancellors' residences and offices. The approved changes were: 1) projects totaling \$25,000 to \$5,000,000 will require Presidential approval, and 2) projects over \$5,000,000 will require Regental approval.

Background

University of California policy requires that campus chancellors reside in university-designated housing on or near the campus to carry out administrative, ceremonial, and development-related duties. The Tierney University Residence on the Irvine campus was completed in 2001. The House is a total of 9,300 gsf with a major portion of the house (6,300 gsf) designed for entertainment purposes with an additional (3,000 gsf) to be used as a private residence. Last year the Tierney University House hosted more than 1,000 visitors to the house including most of the donors who helped raise the record of \$101 million in private support.

Project Description

This approval provides for wood refinishing. This includes the repair and protection of mahogany wood trim and doors surrounding the exterior of The House. The location of the residence exposes the exterior to prevailing high winds, sun and ocean air. This exposure has caused extensive and unsightly peeling and blotching of the exterior wood trim and doors, which can be observed from a distance. Areas of the exterior were repaired previously in 2004. Refinishing the lower portion of the kitchen and bath vanity cabinets on the private side of The House was also required as a result of water damage.

Financial Feasibility

The total project cost of \$50,321 to be funded from University funds.
