








































## **Diversify** global/international education with inclusion initiatives to provide greater access to study and research opportunities for lowincome and underrepresented students.

In collaboration with diversity offices and student support units, such as advising, financial aid and undergraduate research, SIOs identify student needs and work to reconcile these with financially viable and academically, professionally and personally meaningful programs.





## Initiate and sustain new education experiences.

In partnership with faculty and other stakeholders, SIOs promote global learning opportunities domestically and internationally, such as study abroad, global internships, graduate student opportunities, curriculum on global/international issues, experiential learning, pre-college programs, and many more.





















Coordinate with UC Education Abroad Program (UCEAP) to support system-wide undergraduate education abroad that aligns with campus strategic needs and interest areas.
