Nomination Information and Instructions

1. Nominations for Staff Employees will be accepted between November 1, 2016 and November 18, 2016.

(Late or incomplete nominations will not be considered)

- The program will be offered to 40 45 administrators from UC locations
- Nominations will be accepted for a Northern California cohort and Southern California cohort
- Multiple nominations per location is encouraged
 - Northern California locations: UC San Francisco, UC Davis, UC Berkeley, UCOP, UC Santa Cruz, UC Merced, ANR, LBNL.
 - Southern California locations: UC Los Angeles, UC Irvine, UC San Diego, UC Santa Barbara, UC Riverside, ANR

2. Nomination Criteria: (Nominations of program candidates must meet the following)

- Must be a direct report to the Chancellor or a member of the Chancellor's cabinet (Director level and above)
- Must be in current position for at least one year
- Should possess strong personal initiative and motivation
- Should have the ability to work well within a diverse group
- Must have the desire to make an active contribution to UC
- Must show evidence of leadership experience or potential and meaningful involvement in their workplace or community
- Must have a good standing performance (not on any corrective action plan)
- Must have the commitment and support by nominating sponsor that nominee will attend all 12 sessions, 2 day Systemwide People Management conference, additional project work and graduation. (Nominee will be asked to complete pre-work and submit prior to program start)

The program will include campus explorations when participants will interview campus leaders and have the opportunity to visit and learn about the institution. This provides a direct opportunity to get a sense of the physical, intellectual, administrative and cultural nature of multiple University of California campuses.

The program is rigorous and requires a firm commitment of approximately 100 hours of seminars and intersession assignments. A group project will require an additional time commitment.
