# What is a Sautter award?

- Sponsored by the UC Chief Information Officers – the IT Leadership Council
- Recognizes projects – not individuals
- Given to UC teams
- Celebrates IT “innovation”
- Honors collaboration



# Who is eligible?

- Any team at any UC location (campus, ANR, med center, LBNL, UCOP)
  - Cross campus teams!!
  - Staff or faculty team members
  - Any department or unit
  - No limit on submissions
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- 27 apps a year on average
  - Let's get at least one from every location!!



# What projects are eligible?

- Any project / any area
  - instruction and student service, research, health care, community service, business/finance/administration, technology infrastructure
- Advances teaching, research, public service, or patient care *or*
- Improves the effectiveness of business or administrative processes
- Deployed and in use within the last three years

# Selection criteria



- High rankings for projects that:
  - Demonstrate innovation
  - Encourage collaboration
  - Improve operational efficiency
  - Increase usability/ accessibility
  - Can be shared
  - Enable interoperability / integration
  - Measure success
- Show how it has a positive impact

# What makes an application stand out?

- Be succinct, use plain English, stay within the 5 page limit
- Supply requested information
  - Submitter's information
  - Project leader, team members' names
  - Project description
  - Illustrative screenshots or urls
- Emphasize the solution / impact, not the technology
- Describe the innovative spark
- Highlight the partnerships
- Tell the story





# Selection process

- Deadline: mid May each year (May 15, 2015)
- Submit via email
- Selection committee meets in June/July
- Applicants informed a week later
- Teams make travel plans



# Awards

- Presented each year at the UC Computing Services Conference
- UCR – August 16-18, 2015
- Up to 3 golden, 2 silver, 5 honorable mentions
- Plaque/certificate, announcements, prestige among peers
