of graduate students are at least somewhat satisfied with their mentorship and advising experiences (among those that report having an advisor) While satisfaction levels are generally high, there may be serious negative implications for the 17% of students who are at least somewhat dissatisfied

Meeting frequency is significantly associated with mentorship and advising satisfaction
