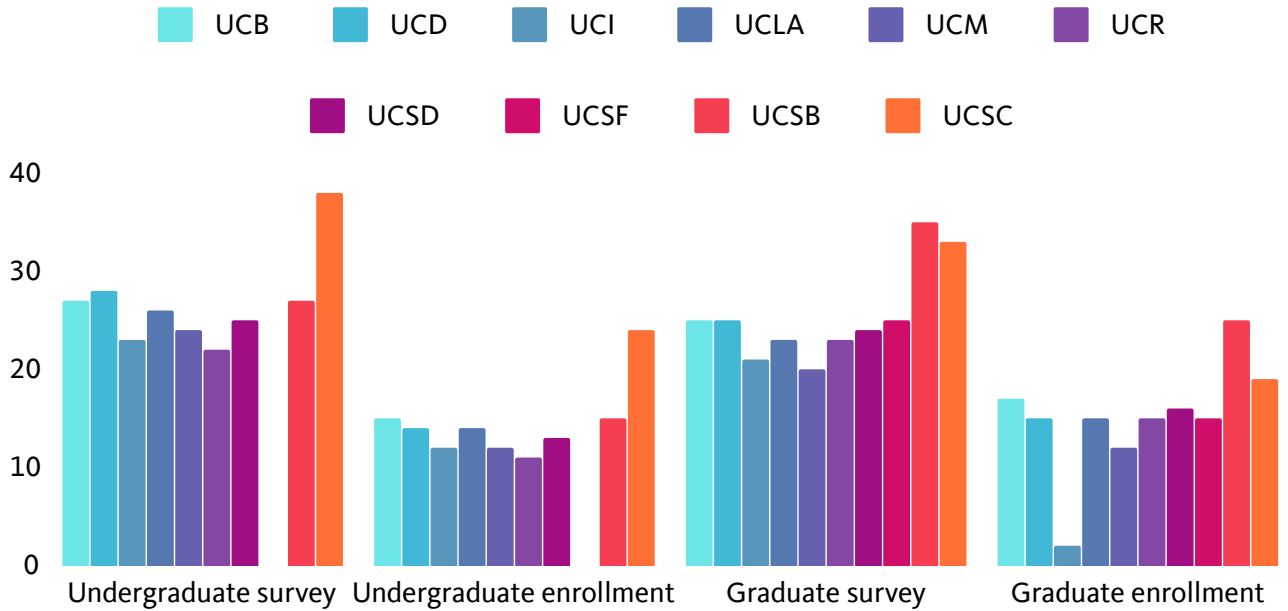


Administrative Data Reforms for LGBTQ+ Representation



Based on confidential survey data, **LGBTQ+ students** likely make up **26% of UC undergraduates** and **25% of UC graduate students**

Confidential survey data shows greater LGBTQ+ representation as compared to enrollment data, a main data source of UC reporting



Most of the undergraduate and graduate students who indicated they were bisexual or nonbinary are **not** recorded as such in enrollment data

Some possible explanations for the data discrepancy offered by content experts

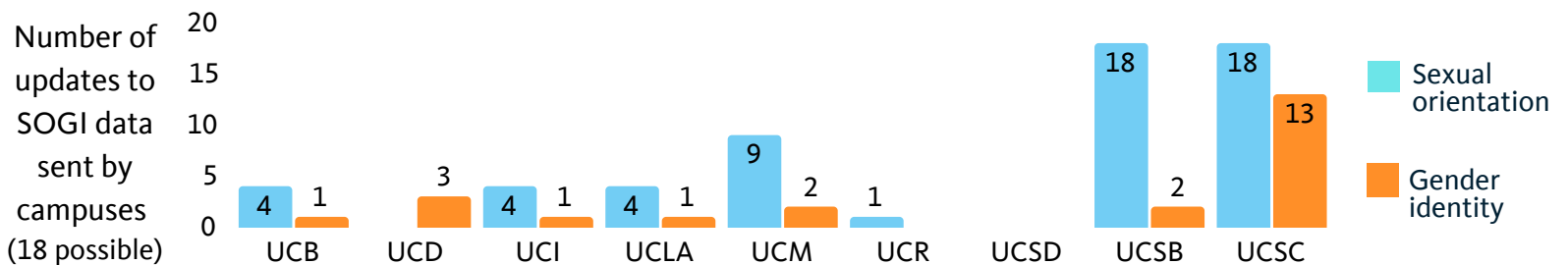
Fear of discrimination on application

Parental involvement in applications

Inadequate answer options on the application

Identities develop over time with exploration

Data suggest few campuses update systemwide SOGI data on a regular basis; for example, only UCSB and UCSC show changes in sexual orientation for possible cohort updates
