2 For undergraduate students, charges for Tuition, the Student Services Fee, and Nonresident Supplemental Tuition are assessed on a cohort basis – all three charges for each entering cohort are expected to be higher than the amounts charged to prior cohorts, but remain flat for the duration of a student’s enrollment, up to six years. For example, charges assessed to cohorts that first enrolled in AY 2021-22 or earlier are displayed under "≤2021-22" and charges assessed to the cohort that first enrolled in AY 2022-23 are displayed under "2022-23."

3 For graduate students, charges for Tuition, the Student Services, Fee, and Nonresident Supplemental Tuition continue to be assessed on a uniform basis – the same rate applies to both new and continuing students, regardless of a student’s entering cohort.
