Re: Compliance with the Department of Defense Tuition Assistance (TA) Program, Return of Unearned TA Funds

Dear Colleagues,

I am writing to provide guidance on the return of unearned Tuition Assistance (TA) funds to comply with the Department of Defense requirements regarding its TA Program, which provides tuition reimbursement for eligible students who are Active Duty, Reserve, and National Guard service members. In accordance with DoDI 1322.25, campuses are to post on their website schedules for the return of “any unearned TA funds on a proportional basis through at least the 60 percent portion of the period for which the funds were provided. TA funds are earned proportionally during an enrollment period, with unearned funds returned based upon when a student stops attending.”

Accordingly, campuses are to post schedules that meet the following criteria:

1. Title the schedule “DOD Unearned Tuition Assistance Return Schedule;”
2. Separate schedules for different enrollment periods, for example, one for quarter-long programs and one for semester-long programs;
3. Each schedule must identify the total number of days in the term; and
4. There must be a specific day that identifies the return at the 60% point in the term in which 25% of unearned TA is returned.

Displays 1 and 2 are examples of the criteria applied to quarter- and semester-long programs:

<b>Day(s)</b>	<b>Unearned TA Returned</b>
0-1	100%
2-11	90%
12-27	50%
28-62	25%
63	25% (60% of course is completed)
64-105	0%

For academic programs that use other periods of instruction, such as various professional school programs, campuses are to post schedules specific to those enrollment periods that meet the criteria above and modeled after the following schedule, in which “XX” refers to specific days:

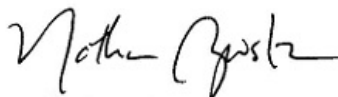

XX-XX (11%-25% elapsed)	50%
XX-XX (26%-59% elapsed)	25%
XX (60% elapsed)	25% (60% of course is completed)
XX-XX (61%-100% elapsed)	0%

The guidance on the return of unearned TA funds supplements guidance on the per-unit Tuition rates for TA recipients.
