

High-Containment Laboratory Oversight Committee (HCLOC)

The purpose of the University of California systemwide High-Containment Laboratory Oversight Committee (UC HCLOC) is to support best practices through the development of policies and guidance.

Membership is comprised of 17 voting members:

- Includes two representatives from each location with an active HCLOG (currently 8): the HCLOG Faculty Chair and the High-Containment Lab Director
- BSL-3 Training Center of Excellence



High-Containment Laboratory Oversight Group (HCLOG)

Local high-containment committee responsible for oversight of local BSL-3 research activities, operations and maintenance of the facilities, and coordination of high-containment training and emergency preparedness.

Locations have latitude in local membership which may include:

- Faculty researchers
- EH&S
- Facilities Maintenance
- Police Department
- Finance
- Senior Leadership



Biosafety Level 3 (BSL-3) Training Center

Provides subject matter expertise and support to the HCLOC.

Develops and delivers integrated training for high-containment laboratory personnel in:

- Operations and support
- Researchers and biosafety professionals
- First responders
