## Use of Proposition 56 Funding: 2020-2021 Appropriation

In 2018, University of California Health (UCH) entered into an agreement with Physicians for a Healthy California (PHC) for the purpose of developing, administering, and managing a statewide Graduate Medical Education (GME) grant program (known as "CalMedForce") created and funded by Proposition 56.

**Application Period:** August 7, 2020 through September 21, 2020

Award notification: November 18, 2020

**Total award amount:** \$38,140,000

First payment to 2020-2021 awardees sent/approved in Fall of 2021. Subsequent payments, over the course of three or four years, are made upon approval of required reports per the CalMedForce program.
